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# VISITOR GUIDELINES & SAFEGUARDING

Malvern College is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people. We expect all staff, volunteers, and visitors to share this commitment. Due to the open perimeter and multiple entry points, access cannot be entirely controlled. However, we maintain security through vigilant staff, clear signage, and designated entry points such as Main Reception.

## **SAFEGUARDING & SECURITY**

- Unidentified individuals on site should be approached politely and asked to identify
  themselves and their purpose. If necessary, they should be directed to Reception or a
  member of the Events Team.
- Visitors must refrain from using cameras or mobile devices (e.g., mobile phones/tablets) to take photographs of any individuals on school premises unless explicit permission has been granted.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

- Your safety and well-being are a priority. As a visitor, you have a legal duty to ensure the health and safety of yourself and others.
- The campus operates strict no nut, no alcohol, no smoking, no vaping and no chewing gum policies.

### **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES & INCIDENT REPORTING**

- In the event of a fire alarm, exit the building via the nearest exit and proceed to the designated Assembly Point. Do not re-enter the building until instructed.
- Any illness, injury, or accident must be reported to the Events Team.

# **VISITOR PROTOCOL**

## **ARRIVAL & IDENTIFICATION**

- Unless specifically advised differently, all visitors must report to Main Reception
- All visitors must sign in, providing details such as name, organisation (if applicable), intended destination, and vehicle registration.

### **EXTERNAL FACILITY USE AND PUBLIC EVENTS**

- The names of all visitors, apart from audience and spectators, must be provided in advance and recorded in the visitor log.
- All adult Malvern College summer visitors will be issued a yellow lanyard upon arrival.
- Visitors under the age of 18 remain the responsibility of their group leaders, who must hold contact details for each minor in their care.
- Entry to boarding houses is strictly controlled; only pre-registered visitors may enter an allocated boarding house.
- Certain areas, including Big School, St Edmund's Hall, Rogers Theatre, Gryphon Room, The Grub, Chapel, and Court Road playing fields, may be open for scheduled events.
- College facilities, such as Malvern Active may be accessed via pre-approved external partnerships.
- Please keep dogs on a lead and clear up any dog mess.

All Visitors are asked to adhere to site rules and access restrictions.

### **DEPARTURE**

Visitors must sign out with their Group Leader or with the Events Team and return their lanyard before leaving the site.

### PARKING & PROPERTY RESPONSIBILITY

- Vehicles should be parked in designated visitor parking areas.
- Vehicles are parked at the owner's risk, and the College accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to property or vehicles.
- All residential visitors will be issued with a car parking pass if they wish to leave a vehicle on site.

### **EVENT GUIDELINES**

All external events must be scheduled through Malvern College Enterprises, and organisers are responsible for ensuring attendees use the correct access routes and parking areas.

# WHAT TO EXPECT

### **ROOM TYPES**

 Our boarding houses offer a range of room options, including single, double, triple, and a few larger rooms. All rooms come with their own ensuite shower room for your comfort and privacy. Unless you've requested to share, you'll usually be allocated your own room.

All floors are accessible by lift, making it easy to get around the building.

 Meals are usually served in the dining room within your boarding house, offering a chance to enjoy food together in a friendly setting.

All communal areas are cleaned daily.

Bed linen is changed weekly, unless specifically pre-arranged.
